

NM Licensing LLC ("NM"), petitioner for rule making in the above-captioned proceeding, hereby submits its comments in response to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making, released on October 25, 2004 (DA 04-3333) (the "Notice").

1. NM supports the proposal outlined in the Notice. NM restates its present intention to apply for authorization to modify the facilities of KLAQ(FM) on Channel 248C2 to specify the community of Tom Bean, Texas, in lieu of Durant, Oklahoma, and to make related changes in facilities, should the proposed rule making be adopted. If that modification application is granted, NM will timely construct the modified facilities for Channel 248C2 at Tom Bean.

2. In further support hereof, NM incorporates by reference the arguments made and the data submitted in its petition for rule making filed on September 3, 2004, and referenced in the Notice at paragraph 1.
