Verizon Wireless, by counsel, hereby files the instant *ex parte* notification in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b). In meetings on December 1 and December 20, 2004, Verizon Wireless representatives discussed with Commission staff a number of issues relevant to the above-captioned proceedings.¹ In particular, Verizon Wireless discussed its compliance with the Assurance of Voluntary Compliance ("AVC") entered into between Verizon Wireless and a number of state Attorneys General and state consumer protection agencies (collectively, the "States").

Attached for the record is an executed copy of the AVC. The States entered into similar AVCs with Cingular Wireless and Sprint Corporation.
