On Wednesday, January 12, 2005, Diane Cornell, Vice President, Regulatory Policy, and Paul Garnett, Director, Regulatory Policy, CTIA – The Wireless Association™, along with Chuck Jackson, Jackson Telecom Consulting, met with John Muleta, Chief, Peter Tenhula, Acting Deputy Chief, David Furth, Associate Chief/Counsel, Tom Stanley, Chief Engineer, Roger Noel, Chief, Mobility Division, Greg Vadas, Legal Advisor of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Julius Knapp, Deputy Chief, Bruce Franca, Deputy Chief, Ira Keltz, Chief, Electromagnetic Compatibility Division and Ron Chase, Technical Analysis Branch Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology to discuss CTIA's proposal to modify base station Equivalent Isotropically Radiated Power ("EIRP") limits for PCS licensees contained in section 24.232 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §24.232. CTIA has proposed to restate current EIRP limits for PCS licensees with ones based on power spectral density. At the meeting, CTIA discussed the attached presentation.
