**WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY STAY**

Telenor Satellite Services, Inc., on behalf of itself and its affiliate Telenor Satellite Services AS (together, "Telenor") hereby withdraws the Request for a Temporary Stay of the effective date of the Commission's recent Report and Order in the above-referenced proceeding that it filed with the Commission on January 18, 2005.<sup>1</sup> Telenor has discussed the matter with the International Bureau staff and has concluded that, due to the Office of Management and Budget approval process that is required under the Paperwork Reduction Act before the operative rules can become effective, the requested temporary stay is not necessary.
