
On January 27, 2005, Dean M. Johnson, Chief Executive Officer of First Avenue Networks, Inc. ("First Avenue"), met with Peter Tenhula, Joel Taubenblatt, Uzoma Onyeije, William Huber, Charles Oliver, Linda Ray, and Martha Stancill to discuss issues raised in the pending Third Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above-captioned docket. In addition, Andrew D. Lipman and Catherine Wang of Swidler Berlin LLP, outside counsel to First Avenue, attended this meeting.

During the meeting, First Avenue discussed its business experience in the millimeter wave market and the nature and extent of consumer demand for additional millimeter wave services.
