

I understand that the Consumer Bankers Association (CBA) has chosen to challenge Indiana's Telephone

Privacy law in a proceeding before the Federal Communications Commission.

The CBA is attempting to impose the federal "established business relationship" exemption on Indiana consumers.

If they're successful, anyone that has a business relationship (with their bank, credit card company, long distance carrier, etc.) will be able to call as often as they want.

This email is to let you know I am strongly opposed to the requested exemption and I ask to have this FCC petition (docket number 02-278) be withdrawn immediately. The efforts of Indiana's Attorney General, Steve Carter have been super & this exemption would greatly deter any advances made in this area of citizen privacy.
