Harold Salters, Director, Federal Regulatory Affairs, T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), Lorrie Turner, Manager, Federal Regulatory Affairs for T-Mobile, and the undersigned, also representing T-Mobile, met on January 31, 2005 with Daniel Gonzalez, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Martin, and Sam Feder, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Martin, to discuss the Petition for Declaratory Ruling filed by T-Mobile, Western Wireless Corporation and Nextel Communications, Inc. regarding the validity of unilateral local exchange carrier tariffs imposing charges for the termination of calls originating on wireless carrier networks. The T-Mobile representatives explained why the tariffs are anticompetitive and illegal and responded to arguments raised by other parties.

The T-Mobile representatives also emphasized that the Petition, which has been pending almost two and a half years, should be granted expeditiously to prevent further harm to consumers. The illegal tariffing practices addressed by the Petition are spreading, impeding competition in rural areas. Accordingly, immediate resolution of this long-standing dispute is of the highest priority for T-Mobile and its customers.

The views expressed by the T-Mobile representatives during the meeting tracked the positions set forth in T-Mobile's filings in this proceeding and summarized in the attached presentation, which was distributed at the meeting.
