Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 3, 2005, Paul Nash and Charon Phillips of Verizon Wireless, and the undersigned on behalf of Verizon Wireless, met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and his senior legal advisor Barry Ohlson. In the meeting, Verizon Wireless discussed the pending wireless-related petitions in the *Intercarrier Compensation* docket.¹ Verizon Wireless's advocacy was consistent with its prior positions in this docket. Specifically, we urged the Commission to grant the wireless-specific petitions as soon as possible.

We also briefly touched on the ancillary terrestrial component ("ATC")/Mobile Satellite Service ("MSS") proceeding. We urged the Commission to ensure that the primary purpose of MSS licenses remains satellite service, and that ATC is truly ancillary.
