Dear Mr. Wilhelm:

This office is counsel to PCIA - The Wireless Infrastructure Association. On December 22, 2004, the Commission released a *Supplemental Order and Order on Reconsideration* (“*Supplemental Order*”) in WT Docket No. 02-55.¹ In paragraph 68 of the *Supplemental Order*, the Commission requested that any of the frequency advisory committees designated to coordinate 800 MHz General Category frequencies that are interested in coordinating 800 MHz SMR Pool “Middle Band” frequencies inform the Commission within forty-five days of release of the *Supplemental Order*.²

On PCIA’s behalf, this is to inform the Commission of PCIA’s interest in coordinating the SMR Pool frequencies.
