Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is in response to the information request set forth in the letter dated February 23, 2005 from Mr. James Ball regarding the above-referenced proceedings.

As AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") has previously certified, it has negotiated rates below the relevant benchmarks with the foreign carrier that possesses market power at the foreign end of the U.S. Philippines route. *See* Letters dated September 24, 2004 & October 4, 2004 to Ms Marlene Dortch, Secretary, FCC, from James Talbot, AT&T, IB Docket Nos. 02-234, 96-321. Since March 2003, AT&T has entered into interim arrangements with the Philippines Long Distance Telephone Company ("PLDT") that provide rates that are significantly below the 19-cent benchmark rate for this route.


AT&T's interim arrangements with PLDT and other Philippine carriers have been periodically renegotiated. As the result of these negotiations, AT&T has obtained additional rate reductions with PLDT.
