Re: Supplement to Applications Filed in WC Docket No. 05-40, *AmericaSky Corporation and Americatel Corporation Seek FCC Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations and a Declaratory Ruling on Foreign Ownership*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Americatel Corporation and AmericaSky Corporation (“Applicants”), through their undersigned counsel, hereby notify the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) that Almendral, S.A. (“Almendral”), the Transferee in the above-referenced transaction, has created a new Chilean holding company, Inversiones Altel Limitada (“Inversiones”), to hold its shares of Empresa Nacional de Telecomunicaciones S.A. (“ENTEL-Chile”). Inversiones is 99.99% owned by Almendral Telecomunicaciones S.A., which in turn is a wholly-owned Chilean subsidiary of Almendral. Almendral directly owns the other 0.01% of Inversiones. The creation of a wholly-owned Almendral subsidiary to hold the ENTEL-Chile shares was contemplated in the Applicants’ applications,<sup>1</sup> and referenced in the Commission’s Public Notice, DA 05-383, p.2, footnote 8, released February 11, 2005 and will not change Almendral’s status as the Transferee. Therefore, this addition does not require an additional public notice or change to the comment cycle.
