Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the request of the staff of the International Bureau, Americatel Corporation and AmericaSky Corporation (“Applicants”), through their undersigned counsel, hereby confirm that Chile, a member of the WTO, is the principal place of business for the new holding company subsidiaries of Almendral, S.A. (“Almendral”) reported to the Federal Communications Commission on March 14, 2005. Specifically, Inversiones Altel Limitada and Almendral Telecomunicaciones S.A. (together “Subsidiaries”) are holding companies organized under the laws of Chile. The Subsidiaries’ executive officers and directors are Chilean, and they are indirectly owned and controlled by the same group of Chilean investors as described in detail with respect to Almendral in the previously filed applications. Moreover, to the extent that these Subsidiaries own any tangible property, it is located in Chile, and Chile will be the country from which they derive their greatest revenues. In addition, the Applicants confirm that none of these Subsidiaries has an interlocking directorate with any foreign carrier.
