Dear Ms. Erana:

This is in response to your request (dated August 18, 2004) filed on behalf of Radio Bilingue, Inc. (Radio Bilingue) for an exemption from the regulatory fees for Fiscal Year (FY) 2004 for Stations KSJV, KMPO, KTQX, KUBO, and KHDC based upon Radio Bilingue's status as a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code. Our records reflect that Radio Bilingue has not paid the FY 2004 regulatory fees at issue here.

The Commission's rules provide that entities that qualify as tax-exempt, nonprofit organizations under section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code are exempt from the requirement to pay regulatory fees. 47 C.F.R. §1.1162(c). You filed with your request a copy of a letter from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) determining that Radio Bilingue is a nonprofit, tax-exempt entity under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The IRS determination letter that you provided establishes that Radio Bilingue is not required to pay regulatory fees. Accordingly, Radio Bilingue is exempt from paying FY 2004 regulatory fees.

You should note that Radio Bilingue is under a continuing obligation to report to the Commission any changes that could affect its qualification for this fee exemption, such as a change in corporate status or IRS determination. You should retain this letter and submit a copy of it with any future correspondence with the Commission concerning regulatory fees for Radio Bilingue.
