**Fourth Supplement to Missouri RSA #5 Partnership Petition for Waiver of
Section 20.18(f) of the Commission's Rules**

Missouri RSA #5 Partnership d/b/a Chariton Valley Wireless Services ("Chariton Valley"), by its attorneys, and pursuant to the request of Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") staff, hereby further supplements its August 27, 2003 petition for a temporary waiver of Section 20.18(f) of the Commission's rules filed in the above captioned proceeding to provide a further update on the status of its discussions with the Macon County public safety answering point ("PSAP") and Shelby County PSAP regarding Chariton Valley's Phase II enhanced 911 ("E911") implementation status.

As indicated in Chariton Valley's Third Supplement to its waiver request, filed on March 18, 2005, Mike Kindle, the Director of the Macon County PSAP, has agreed to the revised implementation schedule presented by Chariton Valley. A letter from Mr. Kindle confirming the PSAP's acceptance of the revised schedule is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

As indicated to FCC staff yesterday, the Shelby County PSAP has now also agreed to the revised implementation schedule. An electronic mail message from Mary Lu McConnell, the 911 Director of Shelby County, confirming the

Dear Mr. Simon,

As you know, Macon County Enhanced 9-1-1 made a valid request for Phase II Wireless 9-1-1 Service from your company in January of 2003. Since that time your company has encountered various delays in implementation.

It is my understanding that your company is currently negotiating with a company named GBSD for the provisioning of equipment and implementation of Phase II wireless 9-1-1 service. You have advised me that the initial installation of equipment and testing will begin the week of April 4, 2005, and final drive testing and calibration will be completed by May 9, 2005.

Although we would have liked for Chariton Valley to have completed it's Phase II project much sooner than this we reluctantly accept the current time frame as given. We also encourage you to complete negotiations with GBSD, and if possible begin work sooner than outlined.

Although we have reluctantly accepted this new time frame as given, we will not accept further delays in this project.

We will look forward in your efforts to complete this project so that our agencies can deliver emergency services the public expects.


