On March 4, 2005, Verizon provided you with a copy of the back-up data and a description of the methodology Verizon used to identify in its February 18, 2005 letter to the FCC the wire centers in Maine that satisfy the Tier 1 and Tier 2 criteria for eliminating unbundled dedicated transport and the wire centers that satisfy the non-impairment thresholds for DS1 and DS3 loops established in the *Triennial Review Remand Order*.¹ Verizon has recently determined that one of the wire centers identified as meeting the FCC's Tier 2 criteria in Maine – AGSTMEST (Augusta) – was included in error. Therefore, that wire center should be removed from the Tier 2 wire center list of exempt offices. Verizon is taking steps to immediately correct this information which is available on its wholesale website. Verizon is also sending written notice of these changes directly to CLECs operating in Maine.
