

I request that the FCC not approve the pending sale of VOOM assets (Satellite, Uplink Facility, and Frequencies) to Dish Network.

I currently receive my HDTV signals from VOOM. I understand that due to the pending sale of VOOM's satellite at 61.5 and other assets to Dish Network, I may lose Voom's HDTV service. I am very pleased with VOOM and I don't want to be forced to receive a lesser quality and quantity of service from any other source.

I understand that VOOM HD LLC expresses a desire to continue operating Rainbow-1 at the 61.5 location. At this time there is no other HDTV service with VOOM's quality and quantity of HD programming or VOOM's commitment & track record of providing HDTV.

I remind the FCC of their past rulings that side on increased competition and consumer choices. This is clearly in the best interest of the public now and in the future. Therefore, I object to the sale of "Rainbow 1" at 61.5 and other assets to a competing satellite service (Dish Network) that will reduce my choice for HDTV service.
