

SBC LNP Recovery Data Request #2 Sent Via E-Mail On March 23, 2005

Hi Micki,

Here are my questions on the FCC tariff on LNP fee:

- 1) What do (IX) and (RX) stand for?
- 2) The Effective Date on the tariff indicates that it is July 7, 1999 and a footnote indicated by a * says that billing for the Basic SPNP Service start on the tariff effective date. Does that mean that SBC did not start charging the \$0.34 until July 7, 1999?
- 3) Does the Basic SPNP Service Monthly Rate Per Line correspond to the FCC approved \$0.34 charge that SBC can charge to its end-users for LNP recovery?
- 4) Does SPNP correspond to LNP? If not, what does it mean? I would like the definition, not what the letters stand for.
- 5) Does the Basic SPNP Service Monthly Rate Per Line also apply to residential, business, Centrex, and PBX customers? If the Basic SPNP Service Monthly Rate Per Line only applied to residential customers then where is the tariff or language for charging the rates to business, Centrex, and PBX customers?
- 6) How is Basic SPNP Service defined? What is Basic SPNP Service?
- 7) There are Billing Charges and SPNP Query Charges and Rates that recur and non-recur within the tariff. To which customers or types of customers i.e., residential, Centrex, business, and PBX do these charges apply? Did SBC include the revenue acquired from these charges to the \$326 million that SBC calculated as the revenue booked in its general ledger associated with the LNP cost recovery? Do these charges relate to the charges approved by the FCC for LNP costs? If so, how do they relate?
- 8) Are there any other tariffs related to LNP cost recovery that SBC filed at the FCC? If so, please provide copies of those tariffs.
