Petition For Rulemaking

Columbus Community Radio Corporation requests that the Table Of Allocations be ammended to include 93.5 MHz in Columbus, Indiana for noncommercial use only.

Columbus has a population of 39,050 and is located halfway between Indianapolis and Louisville.

The city is often called the Athens of the Prairie because of its love for art and culture.

Columbus Community Radio Corporation currently operates radio station WHUM-LP. We have 100 watts at 46 feet HAAT. This is our one and only chance to serve our people with a full service class A FM station.

WHUM-LP, Columbus Community Radio is a member of the National Federation Of Community Broadcasters and like other community radio stations provides artistiic and Cultural programming that commercial radio can not.

The Case For Noncommercial Use

Columbus is in the B contour of Channel 6 television station WRTV, Indianapolis. New and existing stations in and near the reserved band rule use of a channel in the reserved band out.. Columbus does not need another commercial station. Six commercial stations are already broadcasting from this small town.. Every town in the area with a population greater than 2,00 already has a commercial allotment. Again, this is the last chance for a full service community educational station for Southern Indiana

Petitioner used coordinates of 39-9-6 N 85-52-9 W for these results.


