Verizon Communications Inc. ("Verizon") and MCI, Inc. ("MCI") hereby supplement the transfer of control applications filed in the above-referenced docket on March 11, 2005. Specifically, the parties advise the Commission that on April 12, 2005, MCI Telecomunicacoes Do Brasil Ltda. ("MCI Brazil") received authority to provide communications services in Brazil. MCI, through various subsidiaries, holds a 100% interest in MCI Brazil. Accordingly, Verizon will be affiliated with MCI Brazil after consummation of the proposed transaction being considered in this proceeding. MCI Brazil lacks market power in Brazil and neither MCI nor Verizon is affiliated with any other foreign carriers in that country.
