SUBJECT: *Core Communications, Inc. v. FCC & USA*, No. 04-1423 and *BellSouth Corporation v. FCC & USA*, No. 04-1424. Filing of two Petitions for Review in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that, on December 17, 2004, Core Communications, Inc. ("Core") and BellSouth Corporation ("BellSouth") filed Petitions for Review in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 402(a), of the following order: *Petition of Core Communications, Inc. for Forbearance Under 47 U.S.C. § 160(c) from Application of the ISP Remand Order*, Order, WC Docket No. 03-171, FCC 04-241 (rel. October 18, 2004).

Core and BellSouth are challenging different aspects of the FCC's decision granting in part and denying in part Core's request that the Commission forbear from enforcing provisions of the *ISP Remand Order*.

The Court has docketed these cases as Nos. 04-1423 and 04-1424. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of these cases is Laurence N. Bourne.
