Richard Metzger, Jr., and the undersigned, Lawler, Metzger, Milkman & Keeney, LLC, outside counsel to Nextel, met with Samuel Feder and Fred Campbell of Chairman Martin’s office; Scott Delacourt, Heidi Kroll, Joseph A. Levin, Paul E. Murray, Louis Peraertz, John J. Schauble, Ziad Sleem, and Walter D. Strack of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Rodger Woock of the Wireline Competition Bureau; Jonathan D. Levy of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis; as well as James R. Bird, C. Anthony Bush, Neil A. Dellar, Michele P. Ellison, Kent R. Nilsson, and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel.

During that meeting, the FCC staff described the impending request for information that it intends to submit to Nextel and Sprint. The representatives of Nextel and Sprint asked that the staff give due protection to particularly sensitive competitive information, and that the data request be tailored as narrowly as possible.
