On May 9, 2005, Gary Zimmerman, Grier Raclin, Joanna Lowry, and Cathleen Wasilewski of SAVVIS, Mark Pietro and Larry Strickling of Broadwing, and Tim Simeone, Gary Reback, and I met with Bill Dever, Marcus Maher, Craig Stroup, Gail Cohen, Jon Minkoff, Ben Childers, Rodger Woock, Takeo Iijima, Paul Zimmerman, and Pam Megna of WCB, and Michele Ellison, Jim Bird, Kent Nilsson, Karen Onyeije, Ann Bushmiller, Neil Dellar, and Joel Rabinowitz of OGC.

Mr. Pietro, Broadwing's President, Voice Services, and Mr. Zimmerman, SAVVIS' Vice President of Global Client Service – Carrier Management, covered the topics addressed by their declarations in these proceedings. They explained that both companies depend on special access to provide services to their customers and that the in-region BOC, AT&T, and MCI are the primary providers of special access. The mergers proposed by the applicants would make the already-concentrated special access market much more concentrated, to the detriment of competition and enterprise customers.
