On May 9, 2005, on behalf of Eschelon Telecom, NuVox Communications, TDS Metrocom, XO Communications, and Xspedius Communications, Brad Mutschelknaus of Kelley Drye & Warren LLP, Dr. Simon Wilkie, California Institute of Technology, and Heather Gold of XO Communications met with Scott Bergmann, Legal Assistant to Commissioner Adelstein, to discuss the impact the proposed AT&T/SBC merger would have on competitive markets.
