COMMENTS

Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Petitioner"), licensee of Station KYKZ(FM), Lake Charles, Louisiana, by its counsel and pursuant to Section 1.415 of the Commission's Rules, hereby submits its Comments in the above captioned proceeding. *See Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, ("NPRM"), DA 05-650, released March 14, 2005. In response to the petition, the NPRM proposes the reallocation of Channel 241C1 from Lake Charles, Louisiana to Sour Lake, Texas as that community's first local transmission service, and the modification of the license for Station KYKZ(FM), accordingly. The proposed reallocation will not deprive Lake Charles of local service because seven local stations remain licensed to the community.

The Petitioner hereby reaffirms its interest in providing a first local transmission service to Sour Lake, Texas, as stated in the petition. If the petition is granted, Petitioner will file an application for Channel 241C1 at Sour Lake, Texas, and will construct the facilities if its application is granted.


Accordingly, Cumulus Licensing LLC urges the Commission to grant the petition.
