



Dear Mr. Crawford:

This concerns the petition for rule making you filed in which you request that the Commission amend Section 73.202(b) of its rules, FM Table of Allotments, to allot Channel 232A to Drummond, Oklahoma. To accommodate this allotment, you requested that FM Station KHBZ, Channel 234C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma be reclassified from a Class C to a Class CO station because the existing Class C station would be short spaced to the proposed allotment of Channel 232A at Drummond. At the time your petition was filed, FM Station KHBZ was operating with 100 kilowatts of effective radiated power (ERP), as required, but less than the minimum antenna height above average terrain (HAAT) of 451 meters.

A review of your petition shows that it must be dismissed at this time. FM Station KHBZ has recently received a construction permit for its application (File No. BPH-20041104ARX) to increase its antenna HAAT to 479 meters, which exceeds the minimum requirement for antenna HAAT for a Class C FM station with ERP of 100 kilowatts and is short spaced to your proposed allotment of Channel 232A at Drummond, Oklahoma. Therefore, your petition for rule making must be dismissed.

Accordingly, we are dismissing your petition for rule making.

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 232A at Drummond, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 232A to Drummond, Oklahoma as that community's first local FM service. Drummond is an incorporated community with its own zip code and a population of 405 persons. Drummond has its own Mayor, Kenny Bishop, its own school system, its own volunteer fire department, police department, post office and a number of local churches. Drummond is a community that is certainly deserving of local FM service. The proposed channel 232A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Drummond residents and therefore is in the public interest.

In order for Channel 232A to be allotted at Drummond, Oklahoma, station KHBZ Channel 234C in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma will need to be reclassified to a C0. Pursuant to MM Docket 98-93, I am making a formal request for station KHBZ in Oklahoma City to be reclassified from a C to a C0. (See, Attachment A, Request to Reclassify statement)

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 232A can be allocated to Drummond, Oklahoma, consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules, provided 234C in Oklahoma City is reclassified to a C0. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). (See, Attachment B)



Station KHBZ(FM), Oklahoma City, Oklahoma
Pursuant to MM Docket 98-93

Radio Station KHBZ(FM), Oklahoma City, Oklahoma is licensed to Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses Inc., 2625 South Memorial Drive, Suite A, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74129, (Facility ID 11964), FCC File No. BLH 20000105AAN. The facility operates with a power of 100 kilowatts with center of radiation 372 meters height above average terrain. The above captioned Docket 98-93 provides the mechanism to automatically downgrade a Class C facility to Class C0 when a demand is made for the spectrum, as is the case here. Charles Crawford respectfully requests that the license of Radio Station KHBZ(FM) be modified to specify operation on FM Channel 234C0 instead of on FM Channel 234C in accordance with the above Docket which provides for such downgrades when a demand for the unused spectrum is made, as is the case here.

Charles Crawford, the proponent of Channel 232A/ Drummond, Oklahoma, in accordance with the above Docket, formally requests that the Commission reclassify Radio Station KHBZ(FM) as a Class C0 facility. Charles Crawford certifies that no alternative channel is available for the service he proposes at Drummond, Oklahoma as is proposed in the Petition for Rule Making. A copy of this Petition for Rule Making is being served on Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses Inc., as is required in the above Docket.




