





Dear Ms. Quinn:

This is in response to your petition for rule making filed on April 12, 2005, requesting the allotment of Channel 228A at Columbus, Indiana, and the reservation of the channel for noncommercial educational use.

We have reviewed your proposal and find that it is unacceptable for consideration at this time. A staff engineering analysis reveals that the proposed site at 39-09-06 NL and 85-52-09WL, is short-spaced to the licensed site for Station WQKC(FM), Channel 229B, Seymour, Indiana, and cannot be cured with the imposition of a site restriction. Therefore, the proposal is in violation of Section 73.207(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules. Moreover, the analysis also revealed that there no channels available on the commercial band (Channels 221-300) or the reserved noncommercial educational band (Channel 201-220) in Columbus, Indiana.

For the reason stated above, we are returning your petition for rule making.
