This is to advise you that, on April 1, 2005, Paxson Communications Corporation filed a Petition for Review in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 402(a), of the following order: *In the Matter of Carriage of Digital Television Broadcast Signals: Amendments to Part 76 of the Commission's Rules*, Second Report and Order and First Order on Reconsideration, CS Docket No. 98-120, FCC 05-27 (rel. Feb. 23, 2005).

Petitioner challenges the FCC's action in the above-referenced rule making proceeding concerning carriage of digital television broadcast signals by cable television operators.
