
Re: Applications for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses and

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 9, 2005, Roger Sherman and Michael Jones, representing Sprint Corporation ("Sprint"), and Mary Jean Fell and Renee Callahan, representing Nextel Communications, Inc. ("Nextel"), spoke with Louis Peraertz, Ben Freeman and Sara Mechanic of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The representatives of Sprint and Nextel indicated that the FCC's data request of May 6, 2005, could be fulfilled most efficiently and expeditiously if Sprint and Nextel were permitted to exclude the months of January, February and March of 2004 from the requested data. On May 10, 2005, Louis Peraertz informed representatives for Sprint and Nextel that the companies could comply with the May 6, 2005, data request excluding the months of January through March, 2004.
