**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE LATE FILED REPLY OF  
COMMUNITY TECHNOLOGY CENTERS' NETWORK**

Community Technology Centers' Network ("CTCNet"), hereby requests leave to late file its Reply to Opposition in the above-referenced proceeding. CTCNet attempted to timely file its Reply on Monday April 18, 2005, before the filing deadline. Specifically, CTCNet timely submitted its 40 Megabyte, 1,378 page filing electronically through the ECFS main filing system, at approximately 11:45 PM on that date. However, apparently due to the size of the filing, the FCC's ECFS system was unable to accept and process the submission and rejected it approximately at the cut-off. Attached hereto as Exhibit A, is a copy of that ECFS file rejection notice dated April 18, 2005. Additionally, right before the cut-off and immediately after the rejection of its original filing, CTCNet filed only the 44 page main text of the pleading without exhibits. Although sent before the midnight cut-off, the ECFS receipt for this filing was issued with a filing date of April 19, 2005. See Exhibit B, attached hereto showing filing date at the bottom of the page as April 18, 2005.

CTCNet is hereby simultaneously refiled the entire 1,378 page Reply, including all exhibits, for consideration by the Commission in this proceeding. CTCNet believes that its inability to complete its timely filing was due to circumstances beyond its control. CTCNet was unaware of any file size limitations of ECFS, despite having researched the matter earlier on the


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date of filing. Accordingly, because of the important issues raised in the pleading and attached documents, the public interest would best be served by the acceptance of these documents, submitted within an hour of the cut-off deadline.

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
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
