**Re: Applications for Authority to Transfer Control to Sprint Corporation Licenses and Authorizations Held by Nextel Communications, Inc., WT Docket No. 05-63, Data Request Submission of Nextel Partners, Inc.**

Dear Mr. Peraertz and Ms. Mechanic:

Enclosed are 10 CDs and an index of the files contained therein (NPIFCC 000001 - NPIFCC 000015) that contain the information requested by the Federal Communications Commission in the data request (the "Data Request") that was sent to Nextel Partners Inc. ("Nextel Partners") by letter dated May 6, 2005 in connection with the above-captioned matter.

During our telephone call today with Ms. Mechanic, we notified Ms. Mechanic that, although we have compiled the information requested in the Data Request, we expected our response to the Data Request to be delivered on Monday, May 23, 2005 because of the time required to transport the CDs to Washington, D.C. We offered to produce our response today in electronic format, but were informed that delivery by Federal Express was preferable. In addition, during a telephone conversation between Nextel Partners and your office on May 11, 2005, Nextel was instructed to produce the information requested in the Data Request by county instead of zip code, and was also instructed to provide the requested information in Access database format. Nextel Partners has complied with those instructions, and we believe the enclosed data completes our response to Data Request.

The enclosed CDs have been designated as containing "Confidential Information" pursuant to the Protective Order that has been entered in WT Docket No. 05-63 before the Federal Communications Commission (the "Protective Order"). These CDs have also been designated as "Copying Prohibited" pursuant to Paragraph 6 of the Protective Order because



they contain information so sensitive that they should not be copied by anyone. Moreover, we understand that this information also constitutes records that are not routinely available for public inspection pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 0.457(d). Finally, to the extent not already covered by the Protective Order, we request that the Federal Communications Commission provide notice to Nextel Partners: (1) upon receipt of any request for Nextel Partners' confidential material by any other party; and (2) prior to providing any confidential Nextel Partners information to any other party, in order to allow Nextel Partners ample opportunity to seek a protective order or other relief.
