**Re: Applications for Authority to Transfer Control of Sprint Corporation Licenses  
and Authorizations Held by Nextel Communications, Inc. (WT Docket No. 05-63)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

In order to assist the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) in reviewing the above referenced applications and pursuant to the May 6, 2005, letter<sup>1</sup> from the FCC seeking price plan information, Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Verizon Wireless”) submits five DVDs. Four of the DVDs (VZWFCC – CD 1 through VZWFCC – CD 4) contain the “File 1” retail data for April 2004 through January 2005 for interrogatory 1. This data is pipe-delineated text and stored in \*.DAT files. As FCC staff requested, these files can be opened in Microsoft Access. The remaining DVD (VZWFCC – CD 5) contains four files: the reseller data for interrogatory 1; the interrogatory 1 “File 4” retail data for April 2004 through January 2005; a sample “File 2”; and a sample “File 3” file. Neither sample file has been approved by the DOJ.

Consistent with paragraph two of the May 6, 2005 letter, Verizon Wireless requests that the DVDs “be treated as confidential pursuant to the Protective Order issued in WT


