On behalf of Cingular Wireless LLC (“Cingular”), and in accordance with the *Order*, DA 05-423, released on February 16, 2005, in WT Docket No. 05-63 (“*Order Adopting Protective Order*”), this letter is to inform the Commission that Cingular has delivered today to the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (the “Bureau”) the first of two sets of confidential information. On May 6, 2005, the Bureau sent a letter to Cingular seeking certain confidential information.¹ The confidential information delivered today to the Bureau was taken from Cingular’s historical data. It is expected that the remainder of the responsive data, which concerns the historical data of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc., will be delivered to the Bureau no later than June 15, 2005.
