

SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Trinsic Communications, Inc. ("Trinsic") hereby files this Application requesting authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Code of Federal Regulations to discontinue its Trinsic Advanced One Business Service and Select One Business Service in selected markets. These services are carried over high speed broadband facilities to the company's switches and are capable of enhanced voice and data communications services in select domestic areas, where network facilities and systems permit. Trinsic is a nondominant provider of local and long distance services.

I. Pursuant to Section 63.71 (b)(1) through (5) (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(1) through (5)), Trinsic submits the following information:

1. Name and address of carrier

2. Date of planned service discontinuance

The anticipated date for the discontinuance of the service described in paragraphs 3 and 4 below is June 30, 2005, or as soon thereafter as the necessary governmental approval can be obtained.

3. Points of geographic areas of service affected

The proposed discontinuance will affect the provision of Advanced One and Select One business services in the states of Georgia and Tennessee and in select metropolitan areas in Florida: Miami and Orlando.

4. Brief description of the type of service affected

Trinsic will cease to provide Advanced One and Select One services which are domestic services. Service is designed for business customers with five (5) or more outbound lines. Trinsic provides broadband facilities to business customers subscribed to these services. Those broadband facilities terminate in company switches and allow for enhanced voice and data communications services. The company is removing the switch in Atlanta Georgia and terminating services to Georgia and Tennessee customers as well as terminating service to customers in Miami and Orlando Florida. Trinsic will, however, continue to provide these services in New York and in Tampa, Florida. In addition, the company continues to provide other

local and interexchange services (including, but not limited to presubscribed local exchange services, presubscribed toll services, travel card and other services) throughout its operating territory. The company is not seeking to forfeit any state authorization or certification in connection with this application. It seeks only to discontinue the offering of the facilities and switch-based Advanced One and Select One business services.

5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers

Trinsic has provided written and verbal notice to its affected customers. The company is placing phone calls to each customer. In addition the company is providing written notice via certified mail or overnight mail, in order to confirm receipt by customers. A follow up letter will be sent out to all customers who have not migrated service to another carrier by June 1, 2005. Copies of the customer notice text is attached hereto.

6. Nondominance of the carrier with respect to the service being discontinued

Trinsic is nondominant with respect to the services it proposes to discontinue.

7. Service

In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules, Trinsic has mailed a copy of this application to the Governors of the affected states, to all affected State public utility commissions and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense.

II. Circumstances of Discontinuance

Trinsic has determined that recent regulatory rulings have negatively impacted its plans to install additional switches and finds that it is not economically feasible to continue its current facilities-based offerings. The company understands that there are alternative providers for these types of services and will assist customers to the extent possible in providing information regarding alternatives. Once its application to discontinue Advanced One and Select One services is effective, Trinsic will post revisions to Terms and Conditions on its website.

III. Conclusion

Trinsic believes that the proposed discontinuance of services is reasonable and necessary. For the foregoing reasons, Trinsic respectfully requests, pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C § 214(a) and Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules that the Commission approve its Section 63.71 application to discontinue the provision of above-described services.





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
