On June 3, 2005, Patricia Paoletta of Harris, Wiltshire & Grannis LLP, and Heather Dixon of Wiley Rein & Fielding, counsel for Globe Telecom, Inc. ("Globe"), met with Jim Ball, Chief of the Policy Division of the International Bureau, and Claudia Fox, Deputy Chief of the Policy Division of the International Bureau.
