Dear Ms. Dortch:

AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") hereby submits replacement paper copies and a CD copy of certain documents previously produced pursuant to the Commission's April 18, 2005 Information and Document Request in the above-captioned proceeding.

Before AT&T produced documents to the Commission, four privileged documents were removed from the production. Because these documents were pulled from the production after they had had Bates numbers assigned to them, there are now four (4) gaps in numbering sequence. The following documents were removed from the production:

ATT564000343 - ATT564000345
ATT532006377 - ATT532006389
ATT532006390 - ATT532006406
ATT532006407 - ATT532006415

Last week, the Commission notified AT&T that certain of AT&T's documents appeared to have failed during conversion and were unreadable. Upon further investigation AT&T learned that 416 documents that had originally been paper documents but were scanned and converted to searchable electronic documents were incorrectly exported by one of AT&T's production vendors. To correct this export error, AT&T had the 416 documents re-exported, branded and numbered. We have attached a cross-reference file, which will enable parties reviewing the documents to identify the correctly exported document that corresponds to each incorrectly

exported document. Please note that there are 419 entries rather than 416, because in the original production three documents were inadvertently produced twice. These three twice-produced documents are in bold font and highlighted in gray.
