COMMENTS AND STATEMENT OF INTENTION

NASSAU BROADCASTING, III, L.L.C. ("Nassau"), pursuant to Section 1.415(a) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.415(a), hereby expresses its interest in and support for the Commission's proposal to (1) allot Channel 282A to Enfield, New Hampshire, (2) reallocate Channel 282C3 from Hartford, Vermont, to Keeseville, New York, and modify the license of Station WWOD(FM); (3) reallocate Channel 237A from White River Junction, Vermont, to Hartford and modify the license of WXLF(FM); (4) reallocate Channel 231A from Keeseville, New York to Morrisonville, New York, as set forth in the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, DA 05-1021, released April 8, 2005 ("NPRM").¹

I. Background

Nassau has been licensee of WWOD(FM), Hartford, Vermont since November 10, 2004.²

Nassau has been licensee of WXLF (formerly WSSH), White River Junction, Vermont, since October 1, 2004. For the reasons set forth in Nassau's Petition for Rulemaking, the proposed changes in the Tables of Allotments will serve the public interest. In particular, the proposal will serve the public interest by, *inter alia*, providing first transmission service to Enfield and Morrisonville and providing a net gain in population served by Nassau's two existing stations, WWOD and WXLF.


II. Affirmation of Interest

Nassau affirms that if the proposed rule change is adopted and the channels are relocated as specified in the NPRM from to Hartford to Keeseville and from White River Junction to Hartford, Nassau will file an application for Channel 282C3 at Keeseville for WWOD and on for Channel 237A at Hartford for WXLF, and will construct the facilities if Nassau's applications for those modified facilities are granted.

In addition, Nassau hereby indicates its interest in and intention in participating in any auction for the vacant allotments to be created at Enfield and Morrisonville by the adoption of the NPRM.
