Dear Mr. Navin:

On behalf of Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. ("Global Crossing"), we have been asked, by order of the U.S. District Court Eastern District of Missouri, to report by June 24, 2005 on the status of the FCC's deliberations on issues referred to the Commission in the above-referenced docket. A copy of the district court's order is attached for your reference.

The court referral was June 14, 2004,¹ exactly one year ago, and the Commission comment cycle ended on January 18, 2005.² All the commenting parties, except SBC, support the position of Global Crossing and all parties agree that the narrow issue to be decided by the Commission is limited to an interpretation of SBC's tariff. Since then nothing further has
