Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 14, 2005, I conducted a telephone call with Blaise Scinto, Jennifer Tomchin and Peter Corea of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau in response to the staff's inquiry regarding the advanced wireless service ("AWS") band plan addressed in the above-captioned proceeding. Specifically, I noted that T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") supports a band plan that will allow carriers of varying sizes to aggregate spectrum to better serve their customers. I also reiterated T-Mobile's position that this objective can be best achieved by assigning six licenses within the AWS band and ensuring that spectrum blocks allocated by regional economic area groupings (REAGs) do not exceed 40 MHz in the aggregate.
