
ELIGIBILITY

Section 78.13(a) of the Commission's rules provides that an owner or operator of a cable television system is eligible to hold a Cable Television Relay Station ("CARS") license. As described in Exhibit B-2 hereto, the Applicant herein is acquiring the assets of the cable television systems served by the subject CARS stations. Accordingly, Applicant is eligible to be the licensee of the subject CARS stations.

The Applicant's ownership and operation of the subject CARS stations will not contravene any of the Commission's cross-ownership rules.

EXHIBIT B2

DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION

This application arises from a series of agreements involving Adelphia, Comcast, and Time Warner Cable. As a result of the transactions contemplated by these agreements: (1) Time Warner Cable and Comcast will each acquire various cable systems that, in the aggregate, comprise substantially all of the domestic cable systems now owned or managed by Adelphia (the "Adelphia Transactions"); (2) Time Warner Cable and Comcast will swap certain cable systems, including certain cable systems newly acquired from Adelphia and certain cable systems that they each currently own (the "Swap Transactions"); (3) Time Warner Cable will redeem Comcast's existing equity and partnership interests in Time Warner Cable and Time Warner Entertainment Company, LP, in exchange for the distribution to Comcast of certain cable systems and cash (the "Redemption Transactions"); and (4) Time Warner Cable will emerge as a publicly traded company, voting control of which will continue to be held by Time Warner Inc.

This application, and the applications being filed concurrently herewith, seeks Commission consent to accomplish the various license assignments and/or transfers of control necessary to effectuate the Adelphia Transactions, the Swap Transactions, and the Redemption Transactions. A Public Interest Statement and copies of the agreements referenced above are being submitted to the Commission concurrently herewith and can be found in MB Docket No. 05-192.

This particular application pertains to the Adelphia Transactions. It is being submitted pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of April 20, 2005, between Adelphia Communications Corporation and Comcast Corporation, as well as an Exchange Agreement, dated as of April 20, 2005, among Time Warner Cable Inc., Comcast Corporation, and certain related entities. The application seeks approval to assign the referenced licenses held by Adelphia subsidiaries to Comcast subsidiaries. This will be accomplished by a transfer of control of the existing Adelphia subsidiaries to Comcast and a concurrent pro-forma assignment to different Comcast subsidiaries.
