On Wednesday, June 15, 2005, Paul Garnett, Director, Regulatory Policy, CTIA – The Wireless Association™, along with Cheryl Tritt, Morrison & Foerster, LLP, Charles McKee and Luisa Lancetti from Sprint, met with Michelle Carey, Legal Advisor for Wireline Issues, Office of Chairman Kevin J. Martin, to discuss a petition filed by Sprint Corporation asking the Commission to clarify a long-established law permitting wireless carriers to designate separate rating and routing points for the exchange of local traffic.
