Notice of Ex-Parte Communication

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Thursday, June 16, 2005, members of the industry meet with the Wireline Competition Bureau's Telecommunications Access Policy Division (TAPD). The following were in attendance: Jacquelyne Flemming and Paul Beck of SBC; Mary Henze of BellSouth, Tyrone Keys and Kitty O'Hara of Verizon, Larry Sargeant of Quest, Norina Moy of Sprint, and Narda Jones, Vickie Robinson, Sanford Williams, Carol Pomponio, and Thomas Buckley of the TAPD. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the concerns of industry members relating to implementation of the FCC's "Red Light" rules by the Universal Service Administration Company (USAC).

Specifically, industry representatives expressed concerns with USCA "Red Light" process relative to the following: 1) the lack of notice provided prior to taking collection action; 2) the automatic netting of disbursements against alleged debts without providing the alleged debtor an opportunity to resolve the issue; and 3) the possibility that this process may be expanded to other administrative agents of the FCC.
