
Dear Sir or Madam:

Dear friends at Consumer Protection,

I am writing in defense of the Wisconsin state "No Call List." I appreciate this law, participate, and truly hope that other agencies will mind their own stupid business and let us have this tool.

In the first place, why should I not have the right to ask, even insist, that certain callers not call? If I have a crazy relative, nasty neighbor or creep coworker, I can insist that they not call. If they continue I can label it harassment and demand that they not call. It is difficult and messy, but I have the right to say do not call.

Also, with caller ID, I no longer answer callers I cannot identify anyways. They can leave a message if they choose, and most times they do not choose. I do this to avoid the endless flood of calls from charities and other non-profits.

Before I had caller ID, I did not waste my time with callers I didn't want anyways. I just told them **NO**, and hung up. If they called the next day, I didn't even tell them no, and eventually most of them got it. But it is a nuisance.

Also I fear for older people who sometimes have great difficulty in saying no to the call, and even the purpose of the call. If they don't want these calls, why can't they just say so?

The "No Call List" is entirely voluntary. Each resident decides for themselves, and has to initiate being on the list. They are not solicited.

Telephone solicitation is the only form of harassment I can think of that is rationalized as commerce. It is harassment because without a no call list, most of these solicitors do not know the meaning of the word NO, and call until you wish them harm. Even after...

Apparently a small group of special business interests including banks and possibly telemarketing companies think they know what's best for consumers. That is not the case, especially in Wisconsin.






