On June 10, 2005, Michael Altschul, Senior Vice President and General Counsel of CTIA – The Wireless Association®, sent the attached letters to Catherine Seidel, Acting Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Monica Desai, Chief of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau. In the letters, CTIA outlined certain regulatory issues associated with the implementation of the FCC's new rules governing the Section 106 historic preservation review process and the FCC/USET Voluntary Best Practices Agreement that threaten the continued build out of wireless telecommunications systems. CTIA also provided constructive suggestions on ways to improve these processes so that they meet the Commission's intended goals. Copies of these letters were also sent to the FCC Chairman, the Commissioners, their Legal Advisors as well as relevant bureau staff that work on these issues.
