On Wednesday, June 29 and Thursday, June 30, 2005, Diane Cornell, Vice President, Regulatory Policy, CTIA – The Wireless Association™ spoke by phone with John Branscome, Acting Legal Advisor for Wireless, Technology and International Issues, Office of Commissioner Abernathy, Paul Margie, Legal Advisor on Spectrum and International Issues, Office of Commissioner Copps, Barry Ohlson, Senior Legal Advisor for Spectrum and International Issues, Office of Commissioner Adelstein and Jim Schlichting, Deputy Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, in order to discuss the requirement in section 20.18(g)(1)(v) of the Commission's Rules that imposes December 31, 2005 as the deadline for 95 percent penetration of location-capable handsets. CTIA discussed the need to give wireless carriers meeting certain criteria additional time to satisfy the penetration threshold.
