On July 1, 2005, Steven Teplitz, Vice President and Associate General Counsel, Time Warner Inc. and the undersigned had separate meetings with Catherine Bohigian, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, Rudy Brioché, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, and Jordan Goldstein, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps, to discuss the Commission's consideration of an "either/or" must-carry proposal during the DTV transition. In particular, we stressed that an "either/or" approach would be inconsistent with the Commission's January 2001 and March 2005 decisions against dual must-carry and would in no way advance the transition.
