

I have had only one experience with the Indiana "Do Not Call List" and do not want to lose the advantage I enjoyed because the Indiana law provides greater protection than the federal law.

I had accepted a time-share discount vacation offer 1-1/2 years ago and participated in the obligatory time-share tour without buying into the program. About 6-months ago (6 months after my last contact with the offering company) I began getting phone calls again.

Because my last contact had been less than 180 days, the federal program allowed the company to contact me again regardless that I had not initiated contact within that time. Because I was registered with the state of Indiana's "Do Not Call List," I was able to get assistance from the Indiana Attorney General's office to stop the harassment. I could not have gotten assistance under the federal program and would have been subjected to continuous harassment.
