Pursuant to 47 CFR §1.1206, this will disclose that in connection with this permit-but-disclose proceeding, on behalf of MMTC I held a meeting on July 5, 2005 at 11:00 AM with Jordan Goldstein, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps, and Rudy Brioche, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. At 2:30 PM, I held a similar meeting with representatives of the Media Bureau, including Donna Gregg (Chief) and these staff members: Erin Dozier, Robert Ratcliffe, Royce Sherlock, Roy Stewart, and Mania Baghdadi. At the 2:30 PM meeting I was accompanied by Bryan White, a student intern with MMTC.

At each of these meetings, we discussed the items described in the attached document entitled "The Prometheus Remand" and dated July 5, 2005. The meetings each focused on the manner in which the anticipated remand order, and the Commission's fact-finding and information gathering during the public comment period, would draw attention to and illuminate several potential initiatives aimed generally at promoting diversity and specifically at promoting ownership by socially and economically disadvantaged businesses, including those owned by minorities.
