This is to inform you that on Thursday, June 30, 2005, S. Douglas Hutcheson, President and CEO; Robert Irving, Senior Vice President and General Counsel; Tim Ostrowski, Vice-President, Business Development; Doug Byrns, Public Affairs and the undersigned, all representing Leap Wireless International, Inc., on behalf of itself and its affiliated Cricket entities (collectively, "Leap"), met in a series of meetings with the following representatives of the Commission: Fred Campbell, acting legal advisor to Chairman Kevin Martin; Commissioner Michael Copps and his legal advisor, Paul Margie; Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and his senior legal advisor, Barry Ohlson; Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy and her acting legal advisor, John Branscome; David Furth, Associate Bureau Chief, Scott Delacourt, Paul Murray and D'wana Terry of the Office of the Bureau Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Nese Guendelsberger, Eli Johnson, Won Kim, and Marty Liebman, Spectrum and Competition Policy Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

While the focus of these meetings was the current description and status of Leap's services and discussion of general wireless industry topics, there was discussion concerning the status of the Commission's automatic roaming proceeding, as well as Leap's general experience in securing automatic roaming agreements with other CDMA-based carriers. Leap urged the Commission to reinvigorate its investigation and consideration of roaming issues in the above-captioned docket.
