On July 11, 2005, Julie Patterson, Vice President and Chief Counsel, Telephony, Time Warner Cable ("TWC"); Steven Teplitz, Vice President and Associate General Counsel, Time Warner Inc.; and the undersigned met first with members of the Wireline Competition Bureau, including Julie Veach, Nick Alexander, Ian Dillner, Christi Shewman, Carol Simpson, and Tim Stelzig, and then separately with Michelle Carey, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, to discuss issues in the above-captioned proceedings.

As outlined in the attached powerpoint presentation, during these meetings we described TWC's Digital Phone offering and its E911 capabilities. With more than 500,000 subscribers, TWC Digital Phone is a facilities-based VoIP service available in all 31 of TWC's divisions. Since testing the service in 2002 and launching in 2003, TWC has provided E911 service as part of its Digital Phone product and disclosed to customers the ways in which the service differs from those offered by traditional wireline providers, for instance that the service will not operate in the event of a loss of electrical power. TWC reaffirmed its commitment to providing E911 service and making all necessary disclosures and notifications. In addition, we also discussed various implementation issues relating to the Commission's recent *First Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-captioned dockets.
