MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Nextel Communications, Inc., files this motion pursuant to Section 1.46 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission, 47 C.F.R. § 1.46, requesting that the Commission extend the period for all interested parties to file reply comments in the above-captioned proceeding from July 25, 2005, to August 8, 2005.

The Commission released its Second Report and Order, Declaratory Ruling, and Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in these dockets on March 18, 2005. Initial comments were filed on June 24, 2005. More than 4,000 filings have been made in these dockets since the date on which initial comments were due. While most of those filings appear to be nearly identical one-page form letters, at least two dozen substantive comments were filed, including, for example, a 29-page single-spaced filing by the National Association of Attorneys General. A two-week extension will enable parties to more fully review and respond to the initial comments and thus facilitate development of a more useful record for the Commission's review. This modest extension would not prejudice any party.

Nextel therefore urges the Commission to grant a two-week extension to file reply comments in these dockets.
